



## June 2026 Assessment Week Schedule

**For students registered in courses with final exams, please review this schedule to make yourself aware of the dates, time, and locations. Keep in mind:**

- to read and understand the Student Final Assessment and Exam Expectations.
- to bring pens, pencils, erasers, calculators (if needed) and student I.D. to each assessment.
- to arrive 15 minutes early to the assessment location to allow time for supervisors to seat students and start the assessment on time.
- to avoid bringing any electronic device to the assessment (this includes phones, i-Pods, and smart watches).
- to only bring approved materials into the assessment and do not bring additional materials beyond those specified by the assessment supervisor.
- that all grade 11 final exams are designed to be written in 1.5 hrs. All students are permitted twice (double) the official time limit (3 hrs) to write the assessment if needed.
- that all grade 12 Diploma Exams are designed to be written in 3 hrs. All students are permitted twice (double) the official time limit (5-6 hrs, depending on the exam) to write the assessment if needed.
- to avoid any interruptions during the writing of the assessment- if a student needs to be contacted please call the main office.
- **Room locations for the exams will be posted in the Upper Hub area on the morning of the exam.**
