Alberta High School Diploma Requirements



1. Minimum of 100 credits

- Grade 10 → 40 Credits
- Grade 11 → 35 Credits
- Grade 12 → 30 Credits



Alberta High School Diploma Requirements

2. Required Courses:

- English Language Arts: 30-1 or 30-2
- Social Studies: 30-1 or 30-2
- Math to the Grade 11 level: 20-1, 20-2 or 20-3
- Science at the Grade 11 level: Bio 20, Chem 20, Physics 20, Science 20 or Science 24
- Phys Ed 10
- CALM

Alberta High School Diploma Requirements

3. 10 Credits, in any combination, from:

- Career and Technology Studies (CTS)
- Fine Arts
- Second Languages
- Physical Education 20/30
- Registered Apprenticeship Program (RAP) Courses

4. 10 Credits in any 30-level course (In a addition to ELA & Social Studies)

Certificate of High School Achievement

Total of 80 Credits including the following:
